Isaias 40:31

But they that hope in the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall take wings as eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Psalms 73:26

Philippians 4:13

I can do all things in him who strengtheneth me.

Isaias 40:29

It is he that giveth strength to the weary, and increaseth force and might to them that are not.

Unto the end. A Psalm for David. The heavens shew forth the glory of God, and the firmament declareth the work of his hands.

1 Corinthians 16:13

Watch ye: stand fast in the faith: do manfully and be strengthened.

Psalms 59:16

Jeremias 32:17

Alas, alas, alas, O Lord God, behold thou hast made heaven and earth by thy great power, and thy stretched out arm: no word shall be hard to thee:

Habacuc 3:19

The Lord God is my strength: and he will make my feet like the feet of harts: and he the conqueror will lead me upon my high places singing psalms.

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is living and effectual and more piercing than any two edged sword; and reaching unto the division of the soul and the spirit, of the joints also and the marrow: and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Ephesians 6:10

Finally, brethren, be strengthened in the Lord and in the might of his power.

1 Paralipomenon 29:11
