Proverbs 16:16

Get wisdom, because it is better than gold: and purchase prudence, for it is more precious than silver.

Ecclesiastes 7:10

Be not quickly angry: for anger resteth in the bosom of a fool.

Colossians 4:5-6

Walk with wisdom towards them that are without, redeeming the time. Let your speech be always in grace seasoned with salt: that you may know how you ought to answer every man.

Proverbs 13:10

Among the proud there are always contentions: but they that do all things with counsel, are ruled by wisdom.

Proverbs 19:8

But he that possesseth a mind, loveth his own soul, and he that keepeth prudence, shall find good things.

1 Corinthians 3:18

Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seem to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise.

James 3:13

Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge, among you? Let him shew, by a good conversation, his work in the meekness of wisdom.

Proverbs 13:3
