Matthew 18:20

Yes, if two or three people are together believing in me, I am there with them."

1 Peter 3:8

So all of you should live together in peace. Try to understand each other. Love each other like brothers and sisters. Be kind and humble.

Colossians 3:14

Together with these things, the most important part of your new life is to love each other. Love is what holds everything together in perfect unity.

Romans 12:16

Live together in peace with each other. Don't be proud, but be willing to be friends with people who are not important to others. Don't think of yourself as smarter than everyone else.

Acts 2:46-47

1 John 4:11

Romans 15:5

All patience and encouragement come from God. And I pray that God will help you all agree with each other, as Christ Jesus wants.

Acts 4:32

The whole group of believers was united in their thinking and in what they wanted. None of them said that the things they had were their own. Instead, they shared everything.

Ephesians 4:3

You are joined together with peace through the Spirit. Do all you can to continue as you are, letting peace hold you together.

Galatians 3:28-29

Now, in Christ, it doesn't matter if you are a Jew or a Greek, a slave or free, male or female. You

are all the same in Christ Jesus. You belong to Christ, so you are Abraham's descendants. You get all of God's blessings because of the promise that God made to Abraham.

1 John 1:7
